The card system will be in effect, and this will once again be at the Tournament Organizers discretion. There will be a zero tolerance for cheating, rules abuse or abuse of other players. By coming to this event you agree to hold yourself to a high standard of sportsmanship and fair play.

Unsportsmanlike Conduct: If any bad attitude, bad sportsmanship or verbal abuse is reported to a T.O or witnessed by a T.O or present players, you will receive a warning. Follow up infractions will result in cards being implemented. A second instance of verbal abuse, or any action of physical abuse, will result in being removed from the premises.

Do not, under any circumstances, touch another person, their models or their equipment without their express permission. It's 2024 y'all, consent isn't hard.

Content and streaming permission

If you do not wish to be photographed or on video at the event, or on stream with the ATWN, please inform a T.O on the day or via email in advance. Photos and videos will be taken at the event so if you do not wish to be in any please let us know.

What to Bring:

- Your Army, Warhammer 40k Rulebook, GW and FW FAQ section relating to your army.
- 10th Edition Mission pack & cards (using missions generated in the tabletop battles app is acceptable if first agreed upon with your opponent. Always draw secondaries in the app with both players present)
- Dice
- Tape Measure
- Objective Markers (40mm, all your objective markers must be the same size)
- Player cards for pairing

Data cards, tokens, trackers, and markers are also a great and handy tool for yourself and also your opponent for transparency on your army rules.

Army Lists have the Following Restrictions:

- Must be a list from a current Warhammer 40,000 10th edition Codex/Index/Supplement
- Forge world units are allowed
- 30k IS NOT allowed.
- Legends not permitted.
- Lists are restricted to **2000pts.**

-If you have any questions or queries about your army list, making sure certain entries, combos, models etc. are allowed or want to get confirmation or clarity on a list, please get in contact with one of the Tournament Organizers.

Prize support and awards: *must be present day 2 to be awarded prize support*

The Tacca award (best and fairest) - Highest number of 'Players Player' votes accumulated for the tournament (You can only vote for people you played against in the tournament).

Best General, 2nd and 3rd - *based on placings (Cash for all placings prizes)*

1. *1st Place*
2. *2nd Place*
3. *3rd Place*

Wooden Spoon - *At least you had fun*

Best and worst painted - *Opt in only, present your best and worst work, prize for each*

Lucky Door - *lucky door prizes, walk in and win*

Painting Rules

- All models are to be WYSIWYG to a reasonable standard.

- Using a reasonable substitute to “Counts as” another model is allowed. Must have correct base size and dimensions (see WTC base size guide) and obtain approval from The Pantheon prior to the event.
- If in doubt, send a picture in of a model to a T.O in advance to ask if it is acceptable (Pictures must be submitted for approval).
- Paint judging is done via judge scoring.

-If you are using any 3D printed models or third-party miniatures as “count as” substitutes for Games Workshop miniatures, you must get in contact with the Tournament Organizer and send pictures of the 3D printed/Stand ins that you wish to use and gain approval to do so. If this is not done, then the Tournament Organisers will make a decision on the models on the day of the tournament, and you run the risk of not being able to play that model/models on the weekend.

-If you are unsure of any conversions as well, please get in contact with the T.O’s, best to be safe than sorry.

-All Miniatures in your army MUST BE FULLY ASSEMBLED
